We have a new little girl at the home named Linda. She is about 1 year old and was abandoned by her mother. She was rescued by neighbours after being abandoned for two days and taken to the police station. Investigations are still

going on to find any living relatives, in the meantime she is having a good time with the other small children.



Due to a countrywide shortage of one day old chicks, we have not been able to produce our usual number of broilers , however we are doing all we can to keep on supplying our customers regularly. A new flock of layers has just started producing, please place your orders for fresh free range eggs.



Ishmael has been very busy with furniture orders, we are very grateful with all the support we receive from individuals, schools and projects. We were also able to offer work to some very skilled carpenters from the APDK foundation.





The rains have finally arrived and we are able to produce fresh vegetables and fruits for the children. This represents a significant saving for the Home.
